## Titles

The titles and often indications of content are provisional and preliminary, as all mss. could not be identified exactly or with certainty or exhaustively (many mss. contain additional leaves with minor works left unidentified). We have reproduced the titles previously given on wooden covers or on palm-leaf labels of some mss., but we have studied ourselves many mss. to identify them.

## Measurements.

We have measured all the mss. now found and examined. The first two figures tell in centimeters the length and width of the ms., and they have usually been taken from the wooden boards of the ms. The third figure gives the thickness of leaves between the covers (i.e. the the wooden covers have not been included in this measure). Sometimes a ms. contains leaves of different sizes, in which case different measures are given.

## Photography

Photography done with optical cameras by AP and NN and with a digital camera by MF in 2002, and with digital cameras by all the three in 2003–2004 is indicated in the last column; earlier photography by AP and MF is mentioned only exceptionally, as the relevant data are mostly not at hand now. Together with the present catalogue, we have prepared a collection of digital pictures of the Jaiminīya manuscripts to the amount of 50 gigabytes.

### **1. Manuscripts of the Nambudiri Jaiminīya Sāmaveda**

#### **1.1. Muṭṭattukkāṭṭu Māmaṇṇū Mana**

We have examined the 83 palm-leaf mss. of the Muṭṭattukkāṭṭu Māmaṇṇū Mana, Panjal Village, Trichur District, Kerala, India. The mss. have several different numbers written on them. Śrī M. Itti Ravi Nampūtiri has made at least two lists of these mss., one comprising 45 items; different numbers have been given by him on the palm-leaf labels on first leaves of the mss. (in both cases written with ink). These numbers will be mentioned (in this order, if both are known) below without any prefix in parentheses. Some mss. (mainly the largest ones) had titles and numbers written on their wooden covers with pencil in January 2004 by Mr. Shaji of the Oriental Research Institute and MSS. Library, Trivandrum; these numbers will be mentioned in parentheses, prefixed with S.

We have taken as the basis of our inventory the numbers written on most of the mss. with red oil colour or painted in white or gold on the wooden covers by Asko Parpola around 1985–87; as the original list of AP to which these numbers (prefixed here with P) relate is not at hand now, while many mss. had lost their labels with numbers and titles completely due to their consumption by insects (even within one year, after 2003), we cite only those original P numbers that are known for certain, leaving gaps for those not identified now. The missing titles of these empty P numbers can later be correlated with the new P numbers P 107–P132 assigned by us today (1st Feb. 2004) to the mss. without P numbers.

#### 1.4. Mūttiriññōṭu Mana

Most of the manuscripts belonging to this house have been deposited in the Kānippayyur Mana, where a large number of manuscripts have been gathered from Nambudiri houses for preservation. We could not trace any manuscript of the Jaiminīya-Brāhmaṇa among the manuscripts in the house nor in the Kānippayyūr Mana, in spite of Sreekrishna Sarma's statement in his letter to W. Rau in 1972, which is quoted by Rau as follows: "I am told that there is a copy of JB in the Baroda Oriental Institute, which is most probably of [sic, W.R.] the copy of a palm-leaf which I could not trace out but believed to be in the collections of a Namudiri [sic, W.R.], Mūttirangode, in Kerala. It is believed that this family produced the famous Bhavatrāṭa some centuries ago" (1988 [?]: 25).
